You may review your firm's information in the CUCP DBE database which can be accessed at the California Department of Transportation's website at [www.dot.ca.gov/hq/bep/](http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/bep/) and the City of Los Angeles DBE/MBE/WBE database at [www.lacity.org/bca](http://www.lacity.org/bca). Any additions and revisions must be submitted to the City of Los Angeles for review and approval.

After the three-year certification period, your entire file will be reviewed in order to ascertain continued DBE certification status. You will be notified of the pending DBE status review and any documentation update necessary prior to the expiration date.

The Regulations also require annual updates during this three-year period. In order to assure continuing DBE status, you must submit annually a DBE Declaration with supporting documentation, in the format, which will be sent to you. Based on your annual submission that no change in ownership and control has occurred, or if changes have occurred, they do not affect your firm's DBE standing, the DBE certification of your firm will continue until the three-year certification has expired.

Also, should any changes occur that could affect your certification status prior to receipt of the DBE Declaration, such as changes in your firm's name, business/ mailing address, ownership, management, or control, or failure to meet the applicable business size standards or personal net worth standard, please notify us immediately. DBE certification is subject to review at any time. Failure to submit forms and/or change of information will be deemed as failure to cooperate under Section 26.109 of the Regulations.

Your DBE certification status will be honored by all of the U.S. DOT recipients in California.
